



Steps for PCIT Graduation Day

Step	Directions
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bring client and caregiver into PCIT room. • Set out the toys you used in the pre-treatment assessment.
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make sure you have the completed packet of standardized assessments: CBCL, PSI, ECBI, TSCYC, and Therapy Attitude Inventory
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain to caregiver that you are now going to do the 15-minute observation exercise. • They should be pros at this by now!!
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have child and caregiver seated next to each other. • Give the FM receiver to the caregiver, help the caregiver with the ear bud if needed.
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go into observation room. • <i>Turn VCR on record.</i>
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have <i>DPICS Data Recording Sheet</i> ready.
7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put on headset. • Ask caregiver if they can hear you. • Make adjustments if needed.
8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read to caregiver the first part (CDI) of the <i>DPICS Instructions</i>.
9	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write start time on <i>DPICS Data Recording Sheet</i>.
10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CODE caregiver for 5 minutes! • Write stop time on <i>DPICS Data Recording Sheet</i>.
11	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give caregiver instructions for PDI of the <i>DPICS Instructions</i>. • Observe for 5 minutes. • Make any notes about the interactions.

12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give caregiver instructions for clean-up of the <i>DPICS Instructions</i>. • Observe for 5 minutes. • Make any notes about the interactions.
13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Discuss results of 15-minute behavioral observation. Note improvements in parent skills and child behavior from pre- to post-treatment. • Review Skill Acquisition form with caregiver. Show the improvements in PRIDE skills over the course of treatment. • Review the results of standardized measures. Discuss improvements as well as any reported symptoms requiring other services. • Review the Child Treatment form and discuss treatment gains and remaining concerns.
14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Graduation!!!</i> • Give certificate of completion. • Refer family to other services as needed.
15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write progress notes and chart on PCIT weekly profile. • Prepare to refer for other services as needed, or close case.
