2	CDI Didactic	1 session	<ul> <li>PRIDE Skills teaching session.</li> </ul>
3	CDI Coaching	6 – 8 sessions	<ul> <li>Parent reaches mastery.</li> </ul>
4	Mid-Tx Assessment	Up to 1 session	<ul> <li>Parent completes ECBI &amp; PSI.</li> <li>Optional to complete other measures and 15-minute observation.</li> </ul>
5	PDI Didactic	1 – 2 sessions	<ul> <li>Parent learns how to give effective commands and a PCIT timeout.</li> </ul>
6	PDI Coaching with Role Play	1 session	<ul> <li>Role-play giving effective commands and PCIT timeout with Mr. Bear.</li> </ul>
7	PDI Coaching	6 – 8 sessions	<ul> <li>Parent masters giving direct commands and time out with the child.</li> <li>Child's compliance improves</li> </ul>
8	Graduation from PCIT	1 – 2 sessions	<ul> <li>Parent gives effective commands and manages behavior in different settings.</li> <li>Completes standardized assessment measures, TAI, &amp; 15- minute behavioral observation.</li> </ul>
