SPECIFIC SKILLS TO PRACTICE DAILY

Use your Relationship Enhancement Skills (PRIDE)

- **P Praise** the appropriate behavior that you see immediately
- **R** Use "reflection" to teach your child to listen and communicate
- Model (Imitate & Model) the behavior you desire
- **D Describe** the behavior that you see or want to see that is appropriate
- **E** "Enjoy" your play time with your child by having enthusiastic play

Use **"physical positives"** such as smiles, looking with eyes, hugs, kiss, sitting close. **Reduce** questions and commands.

Avoid NO, DON'T STOP, QUIT, & NOT

WAYS TO USE SELECTIVE ATTENTION:

Stay silent. Turn your eyes away. Play with something else. Keep your facial expression blank. Make your play really fun so that the child will want to play that activity. Compliment or praise another child's appropriate behavior. Turn your back away. Praise child immediately when he/she begins behaving appropriately!
