



PCIT Training Model Outline

Post Web Course Skill Building

- **8 hours** over 2 days
- Complete the 10 hour "PCIT for Traumatized Children" Web Course in advance

Pre-Training & Coding Support

- **11 hours** of Pre-Training consultation and support
- Includes skills practice, DPICS coding practice, and technical support

Group Didactic Calls

- Access to **24 hours** of Group Didactic training
- Group training and video conference consultations every 2 weeks

Individual Trainer Coaching

- **18 hours** per trainee
- One-on-one live coaching and video review from your UC Davis PCIT Trainer

Certification

- PCIT Competencies signed off by a UC Davis Trainer
- Trainees must have access to PCIT equipment
- Trainees must have ability to record sessions
- Graduate 2 successful PCIT cases

Receive over 60 hours of remote PCIT Training from a UC Davis trainer with state-of-the-art training materials and PCIT Treatment Manual & DPICS manual. Receive a "PCIT Provider" Certificate after 12 months of completing training competencies and graduating 2 success cases. Receive an "In House Trainer" Certificate after completing 4 total PCIT cases.
